Requirements for a proper WatchList

Criteria	Requirement
Stock Price	15 ≤ Price ≤ 80
Average Daily Volume (ADV)	≥2 Million shares/day*
Daily Average True Range (ATR)	At least \$1, but ≤ 8% of Price
Beta (Volatility)	1.5 ≤ Beta ≤ 2.5
Spread (during Market hours)	Spread <u><</u> \$0.03

^{*2} Million shares a day is ideal, but 1 Million is adequate


Requirements for a proper WatchList

Criteria	Requirement
Stock Price	Price ≥ 20
Average Daily Volume (ADV)	≥750,000 shares/day*
Spread (during Market hours)	Spread ≤ 0.1% of Price
Optionable**?	Yes
Dividend Yield*** Paying Stock?	Yes

*750,000 shares a day is ideal, but 500,000 is adequate

Is the Broad Market trading inside of a Zone at the same time?

Condition	Best=1	Poor=0	
Broad Market Entering Supply	Stock Supply Stock Supply Stock Supply	Supply Broad Market Between Zones Demand Stock	
Broad Market Entering Demand	Broad Market Stock Demand	Supply Broad Market Between Zones Demand Demand	

Lesson: When a Stock is entering a Supply or Demand zone while the Broad Market is entering a Supply or Demand zone at the same time, the probability for the Stock Trade to work is higher



Income Wiggle Room for Stops





Daily ATR is \$3.13 (The Rule uses 2% of Daily ATR) Wiggle Room for Stop = = \$3.13 x 0.02 = \$0.0626 = -> rounding up = \$0.07
